HORT 100: Introduction to Horticulture

3 credit hours; Tuition \$339, Fees \$140 3 different sections: -16 weeks, January 18 – May 15 -14 weeks January 31 – May 15 -8 weeks March 21 – May 13

Survey of horticultural practices including the selection, use, and care of fruit, vegetable, and ornamental plants. This course is designed to offer the student a general introduction to the principles of plant growth and development as they apply to the wide range of horticultural crops and the industries related to production, marketing and utilization of horticultural crops.
