

Virtual Livestock Judging Series

The JJC Virtual Livestock Judging Series Reasons and Questions divisions will be open to all recently graduated seniors and younger.

There will be one class posted per week for the duration of 6 weeks total. The first class will be posted Monday, July 6th.

Classes will be posted on Facebook on Monday mornings. Entries will be due Wednesdays at 11:59pm (midnight). Entries will be submitted through a Google form. There will be a separate Google form for Reasons and Questions divisions. Questions will be answered in the Google form, and Reasons will be uploaded as a link in the Google form. Each participant will fill out a new Google form each week.

There is no cost to enter. We want to provide a fun, FREE opportunity for young livestock evaluators!

Participants will be scored on their placing and their set of reasons or questions.

Teams will consist of 4 members. The top 3 scores will count. If your county/school has multiple teams please distinguish each team. Ex. Joliet Purple, Joliet White. Teams must remain the same for the duration of the series.

Overall awards will take into consideration the participants' top 5 scores from the series; the lowest score will be dropped. This applies to both Individual and Team Overall awards.
