FFA Chapters in the state of Illinois can participate. FFA advisors need to be present unless special arrangements have been made with Jason Perry AND another person responsible for the team is present. Time slots available **by appointment** after 8 am roughly 30min per 5 person team (**PLEASE PRE-REGISTER** at least with rough numbers before the end of the day September 20<sup>th</sup>.) Thanks to a donation from the McLean County Pheasants Forever and the McLean County Sportsmen's Association, we are planning to continue to provide shells for all participants with their registration. This year it will be \$15 per individual for 2 rounds of 25 birds (50 birds total). Shells will be provided while supplies last to the first teams to pre-register. For this, please indicate the number 12 or 20 gauge shooters you will have as you register. Practice rounds and extra rounds may be available directly through Darnall's depending on space and time availability. This year we will NOT be providing a meal. Darnall's does have a pop machine.

### **Rules:**

- **Eye and Ear protection is required**
- **A short safety meeting will take place before you are allowed to shoot**
- **Shotguns with #7 ½ or #8 shot must be used (and provided by shooter)**
- **Open gun rule will be enforced**
- **All Shooters will shoot from the front line**
- **Safety violations will result in disqualification of offending individuals**
- **Teams will consist of 5 members, all 5 scores count**
- **Ties will be broken by top individual scores on teams**
- **Individual ties will be broken by longest streak without a miss, then by going the furthest from the finish without a miss**
- **Traveling Trophy will be awarded to the top FFA Chapter Team**
