When I was at ILCAE I learned DePaul University is offering Sustainable Ag courses and I plan to meet with Tyler Strom to develop that relationship- it is my hope we can begin to offer an urban AgEd teacher training program in the near future. I would like to begin developing a more "mainstream" "AgEd-lite" model for implementation in AP Human Geography and AP Environmental Science teachers at schools who otherwise could not offer an approved AgEd program.
